YOUNG ART TAIPEI (YAT) Taipei International Contemporary Art Fair is the very first contemporary art fair in Asia that focuses on young artists under the age of 45. This fair aims to be served as a platform for contemporary art in Asia .

Held in May each year, with the participation of excellent galleries and young artists around Asia, YAT has become an important stage for discovering emerging stars in Asian Contemporary Art market.

YAT 2009 took place right after the financial storm stroke the globe. Even so, last YAT delivered a successful sales result due to its professional team's effort, its delicate yet amiable exhibiting atmosphere, the experienced domestic collectors and the participation of 42 International galleries from China, Japan, and Korea, etc.

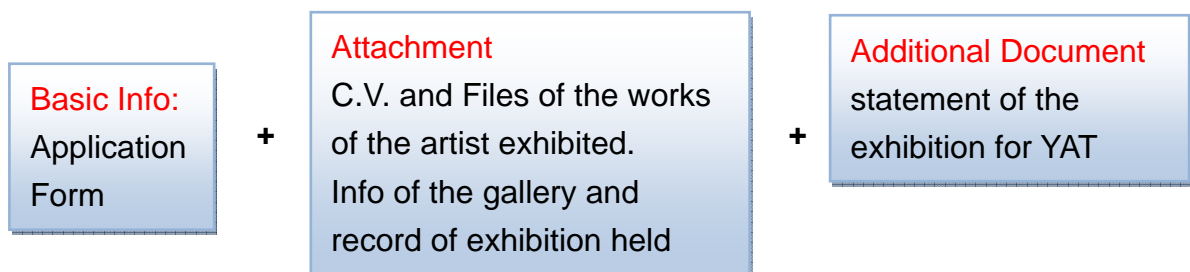

2. Details of participating artists (name, media of art work, age, and nationality) must be included in the application. Artists' biography in Chinese or English contexts and three digital images (300dpi) of art works from each artist can be sent via email.
3. Exhibits should be recent works completed within last two years.
4. List three exhibitions of the gallery within the past year in the application, and email relevant information (catalogues, flyers, etc.).
5. Additional Document: Due to the limit space availability of a hotel art fair, your provision of a proposal includes the information stated in the Additional Document will be certainly enhancing the completion of the application.



Evaluation & Rules

1. The jury assigned by the administration will evaluate the applicants.
2. The participating galleries are not allowed to give way or share the exhibition space to any other gallery.
3. The jury will process evaluations for all participating galleries and artists during the exhibition, for the reference of next year's YAT.
4. TAIWAN CONTEMPORARY ART LINK reserves all rights for admission, and acts according to decisions made by the jury. Acceptance for admission of exhibits, once received, will not be allowed to change without further agreement from the organiser. If information given on application fails to be true and accurate, or applicants fail to follow the conditions stated above, the organiser reserves all rights to cancel admission for exhibitors.

- Accommodation is for exhibitors only; limit two occupants per room. Extra payment will be expected for an additional bed or extension of occupancy dates.

- Daily cleaning services will be provided for exhibitors' accommodation (including bedding, vacuuming, bathroom cleaning and garbage-taking); however, galleries are responsible for individual booths respectively taken for exhibition.
- Exact date and time for all accommodation check-in will be 12th May 2009, after 15:00. If planning for early check-in or early occupancy, please inform the organiser in advance.
- All check-out should be completed by 17th May 2009, 12:00; any additional fee caused by late check-out will not be covered by the organiser.
- Any other expenditures in the hotel during occupancy shall be covered by exhibitor.

YAT committee will send a confirmation email to acknowledge receipt for your application. If you do not receive the confirmation email within 2 weeks of sending out the application, please contact YOUNG ART TAIPEI OFFICE via phone or email.

CONFIRMATION OF ACCEPTANCE

The YOUNG ART TAIPEI COMMITTEE will carefully review all applications and email the qualification results to all applicants in early March in 2010.

As soon as you receive the letter confirming your acceptance, please follow the procedure for payment as referred to in the document accompanying this application.

OVERSEAS SHIPPING FOR EXHIBITS

If overseas shipping is required for exhibits, the shipping can be consigned to the committee. All shipping services will be provided by our sponsor delivery company, and will be automatically receive an "Art Work Exemption" on importing tax. 5% out of the value reported to customs will be charged as a business tax after each art piece is successfully sold. If exhibitors decide to consign any other shipping companies for delivery, the committee will not be able to offer application service for tax exemption. Exhibitors will be responsible for all fees for individual importing tax and customs

reporting.

ONSITE MANAGEMENT & INSURANCE

1. Beginning from the day for setup, each exhibitor should be responsible for the safety of all exhibits onsite until the closing of exhibition.
2. During set-up preparation and exhibition, no staff should enter the venue without a working pass.
3. No exhibits should be removed from the venue during exhibition, unless a permission slip is shown and signed by the manager of the booth.
4. The organiser will cover only liability insurance for public safety at the venue. All exhibitors should follow safety regulations and it is recommended to have exhibit items, including accessories, insured for damages, loss, theft, robbery, fire, floods, and damage during delivery. Each exhibitor must take possible risks and compensate for damages at all circumstances, in terms of damages to exhibits, other exhibitors or booths, audience, and facilities at the venue. The organiser or staff will accept no liability for any direct and indirect damages or loss caused during exhibition at the venue.

REGULATIONS

1. Supervision at every booth is required at all times during exhibition hours.
2. No booth can be shared or subleased by more than one exhibitor.
3. Conditions will be announced at the venue for setup. Any behaviour that would damage the walls or amenities in the room will be strictly prohibited and fined..
4. Exhibitors are obliged to respect requests from the organiser to leave the booth, including evacuating in case of emergency, and empty the booths after the exhibition. Should regulations be broken, all loss and damage costs will be claimable by the organiser.
5. No smoking in any booth.

Force Majeure

In the case of any unforeseen events beyond control preventing the exhibition from running under normal conditions, the organiser reserves all rights for changing or shortening exhibition dates. Any claims for reimbursing or refunding from exhibitors will not be accepted.
